

Revised Guide to Recycling in Sac County Fall 2014

Schaller hauls our recycled items to the Sac County Landfill, so we must abide by these rules they have set forth.

Recycling is picked up in Schaller on Wednesday mornings unless otherwise announced. We rotate weekly pickup of cardboard/paper with glass/metal/plastic. The pickup schedule is posted on www.cityofschaller.weebly.com

Separation is required as noted below. Schaller does not have a trailer with compartments, so this is why we pick up cardboard and paper one week and the next we collect glass, metal, plastic. It should not be the responsibility of the pickup crew to do your separating. Thanks!

Do not use trash cans for recycle items, please. The guys have to lift over their heads to put contents in the truck and that large container is too heavy for safety. Use the rubber type bins with handles on the sides.

GLASS: Wash out containers and remove lids. It is not necessary to remove paper labels. Clear, green and brown glass food and beverage containers only. NO light bulbs, window glass, ceramics, drinking glasses, mirrors, headlights, plates or cooking ware.

PLASTICS: #1 - #7 container plastics are accepted. Wash out containers and remove lids. Cannot accept containers that have held motor oil, vegetable oil, antifreeze or farm chemicals.

OFFICE PAPER: High grade white office paper, computer paper and envelopes are accepted. The materials should be bagged, bundled or property secured.

NEWSPAPERS: Included in this category of recyclables are newspaper, pasteboard egg cartons, non-white junk mail, catalogs, magazines and "slicks." Please separate this category of material from other types and place in paper bag or cardboard box and close securely.

TIN/ALUMINUM: Tin and aluminum cans, pie plates, and foil are accepted. Please rinse/wash.

POP/BEER CARTONS: Pop and beer cartons are accepted. They should be boxed or bundled separately from other cardboard.
